RE, PSHE & CITIZENSHIP LESSONS

We have a team of locally based and experienced schools workers who are able to present lessons on a variety of issues which are regularly covered in Citizenship, PSHE and RE.



We like to do this in consultation with teachers, discussing what the students are learning in that unit of work. We then tailor our lesson plan to fit in with the school's scheme of work and to help the students gain a first hand understanding of what Christians believe on that particular issue.

Our team are also happy to answer questions and participate in discussions with classes on any issues involving faith.



HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS

Raising awareness amongst young people of human trafficking and its consequences will help protect them and their friends from being vulnerable to exploitation. We offer interactive lessons and discussions educating and raising awareness of human trafficking and exploitation.



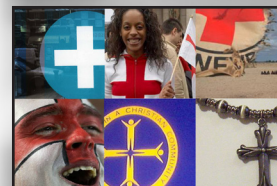
FAITH & VIOLENCE

Since 9/11 the issue of violent extremism has established itself firmly in our national consciousness. This two lesson series of multi-media lessons aim to explore what it is that makes faith give rise to violence. It also examines the various ways in which young people can become part of the solution to violent behaviour in their communities.



CAP MONEY COURSE

We have recently launched a lesson to help students learn how to budget successfully as their disposable income increases.



FAITH IN FOCUS

For a number of years we have participated in 'Faith in Focus' weeks where RE Departments have organised a series of cross-curricular lessons and extra-curricular activities centred on a faith theme. Each project has created its own unique blend and n:flame have worked successfully in partnership with teachers by leading lessons and helping to create links with other speakers and performing arts groups.

N:FORUM

Using the concept of forum theatre we have devised a number of drama workshops on various themes: 'STOP' is about bullying, 'The Problem With Being Lydia' considers self harm and 'By His Stripes' explores various themes including self worth. In each production the students are invited to step into the story and take on the roles of various characters to work out solutions for themselves, which can equip them for real situations they may encounter.

FULL DAY ACTIVITIES

n:flame is able to assist schools in running off-timetable days where a whole year group may participate in a shared activity for the day. In our 'World Trade' day students explore first hand the global imbalance in wealth and consider the challenges of good stewardship, fair trade and constructive aid. In our 'Kairos' day we help students look at how the past and present can impact on their futures and so help them consider how to make positive choices. For these days we only ask that schools contribute to the cost of materials used.

POP UP PRAYER SPACES

This is a hands-on interactive space for students to experience prayer creatively. Whether it be drawing on a post-it, writing prayers on plasters, explore questions for God or dropping a vitamin tablet in water, young people can find their own way to express themselves, be challenged, and deal with personal issues. We aim to enable and resource Christian students to run these themselves in their school, either for a lunchtime club or over a few days.

CHRISTIAN CLUBS

We continue to help schools facilitate Christian Clubs working along staff as they support Christian students. We are able to assist in running a weekly club, open to all students. In an informal setting, they are able consider a variety of issues and explore what the Bible has to say.
